Garbage Collection

It has been noticed that many properties downtown are setting material out 7 days a week. Waste management staff have been leaving friendly reminders and collection guides at properties downtown, **but it is difficult to connect with the residential tenants and the issue continues to persist.**

In the enhanced area, collection day is Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday, and Sunday, the designated business area receives collection on Tuesday.

Any businesses that receive a reminder are asked to forward the information to their landlords so it may be shared with other tenants in the building (such as residential units)

—● ENHANCED DESIGNATED BUSINESS AREA COLLECTION SCHEDULE:

Containerized cardboard collection once or twice per week depending on location

Tuesday:

- Blue/Grey Box or Cart, weekly collection, no container limit - 9 a.m.
- Green Bin or Cart, weekly collection, no container limit - 5 p.m.
- Garbage collection, weekly collection, seven bag/can limit per property - 5 p.m.

Thursday - 5 p.m.:

- Green Bin or Cart, weekly collection, no container limit
- Garbage collection, weekly collection, seven bag/can limit per property

Saturday - 7 a.m.:

- Blue/Grey Box or Cart, weekly collection, no container limit
- Green Bin or Cart, weekly collection, no container limit
- Garbage collection, weekly collection, seven bag/can limit per property


Sunday - 7 a.m.:

- Garbage collection, weekly collection, seven bag/can limit per property

—● DESIGNATED BUSINESS AREA COLLECTION SCHEDULE:

Tuesday

- Blue/Grey Box or Cart, weekly collection, no container limit - 9 a.m.
- Green Bin or Cart, weekly collection, no container limit - 5 p.m.
- Garbage collection, weekly collection, four bag/can limit per property - 5 p.m.



St. Catharines Enterprise Centre supporting entrepreneurs with Starter Company Plus

The City of St. Catharines' small-business support office is gearing up for another annual run of Starter Company Plus. Through the provincially funded program, the team at the Enterprise Centre provides business training, mentorship and a grant up to \$5,000 to help eligible entrepreneurs successfully launch their own businesses.

Since 2013 the centre has assisted 100 new businesses through the program. Of those 100 businesses, 88 still operate, accounting for over 200 local jobs.

The application deadline for this year is Sept. 27.


